*The Pastor's Letter this week is from Tommy Curtin, Headmaster*

Dear OLR Parishioners,

This Sunday marks the beginning of Catholic Schools Week. As Headmaster, it is my privilege to lead a school that bears authentic witness to the truth, goodness, and beauty of the Catholic faith. It is whispered in some corners that Catholic schools must be careful not to be TOO Catholic, otherwise we might struggle to attract the diversity of students we need to meet budget and sustain the program. That is simply false. OLR has become attractive and viable precisely by leaning into orthodoxy, delivered with joy by our dedicated teachers. We are boldly Catholic!

While these bulletin letters are generally an occasion for sharing words of spiritual wisdom, please allow me to share some numbers. They tell an encouraging story about OLR's present and future.

- 100% of OLR staff are practicing Catholics
- 97% of OLR students are Catholic, most practicing
- 75% of OLR school families are parishioners

The school currently has 330 students in pre-K through grade 12. We project an enrollment of 350 for the 2026-27 school year. For reference, in 2017, OLR had 125 students.

- We have received 113 applications for next year.
- 50 of these applications are from siblings of current students.
- Every grade now has a waitlist (more applications than openings)

We expect to graduate 22 students this May. Of these:

- 14 are applying to four-year colleges
- 9 plan to attend a Catholic college
- 8 are applying to two-year or technical colleges

These numbers only tell a little bit of the story. To truly understand what OLR school is, one must spend time on campus interacting with these truly exceptional teachers and students. If anyone reading this would like to learn more about OLR school for any reason, please do not hesitate to reach out. It would be my pleasure to tell you all about what we are doing.

## MOTHER TERESA HOUSE

*“When spirits fall, their darkness is revealed, for they are stripped of the garment of your light. By the misery and restlessness which they then suffer you make clear to us how noble a being is your rational creation, for nothing less than yourself suffices to give it rest and happiness. This means that it cannot find them in itself. For you, O God, will shine on the darkness about us. From you proceeds our garment of light, and our dusk shall be noonday.”* St. Augustine

Today's readings are about darkness into light. The darkness is a struggle for those I deal with at MTH, and the only true answer is the Light, Jesus Christ. We all see people in deep need as many approach us here, or when we are out in our daily lives. We want to help them with what they want, sometimes to make ourselves feel better, even though it does not address what they truly need. The general rule in my community of providers is not to give cash directly to those begging. It often goes into funding their darkness and our charity becomes toxic, even when we had the best of intentions. It is hard to deal with people who do not, or cannot, face their darkness and have no desire to do the work to get out of it. We offer them a path forward, rarely ever easy, but we offer to walk with them or find the best organization that can. We do this to help bring light to their world. Continue your prayers for them, as it only in Him can they have light shine in their darkness.
